Scotty Wallbanger

Pour: 1 oz Scotch over ice cubes in tall glass, then fill with orange juice nearly to top. Float ½ oz Liquor Galliano on top.

Klingon Grog

3 oz Over proof Rum
1 oz Orange juice
1 oz Pineapple juice
1 oz Passion Fruit nectar
Dash Angostura bitters
½ cup cracked ice
Mix ingredients in blender or shaker, pour into beer mug half filled with cracked ice, add olive, serve with straw.

Kirk-A-Kola

To tall glass filled with ice cubes, add: 2 oz California Brandy, dash Orange Bitters, fill with cola, garnish with lemon slice.

Orion Dancer

1 oz Green Crème de Menthe
1 oz Vodka
¾ oz light cream
¼ cup cracked ice
Blend at moderate speed, squeeze in ½ lime while blending, strain into wine glass, serve with lime slice.

It's....Green

¾ oz Green Crème de Menthe,
¾ oz Scotch Whiskey, ¾ oz light cream
Shake with cracked ice and strain into cocktail glass.

The Transporter

1 oz Scotch Whiskey
1 oz Vodka
1 oz Tequila
4 oz Tonic Water
Serve over ice cubes in very tall glass.

Finnigan

Rim cup with sugar, add: 1 ½ oz Irish Whiskey, 1 Tb Crème de Cassis, fill to within ½ inch of brim with hot black coffee, top with cold whipped cream.

Romulan Cola

Pour: 2 oz Vodka over ice cubes in tall glass, add: 2 dashes Orange Bitters, fill with cola, garnish with lime slice.

K-7

Pour 1 ½ oz Kahlua over ice in tall glass, fill with 7-Up.

I'm a Doctor, not a Pepper!!!

1 ½ oz Bourbon
4 oz Dr. Pepper
Serve in large glass filled with ice cubes.

Sulu, it's been good to know you!

4 oz Adadama Plum Wine
2 oz Whiskey
dash Soy sauce
Serve in tall glass half filled with ice cubes.



It's Red, Jim!

1 ½ oz Bourbon
4 ½ oz Tomato Juice
¾ oz Lemon juice
Dash Worcestershire sauce
Salt & Pepper to taste.
Shake with crushed ice, strain into tall glass and serve with mint sprig if available.
